Our tax rates are amongst the lowest in Canada, combined with low-cost housing (average home price of \$146,000). As a well-managed community and one of the most financially stable in the country, Tumbler Ridge is well positioned for growth. With new investments in mining, wind energy, small businesses, and an increase in tourism due to the designation as North America's second UNESCO Global Geopark, Tumbler Ridge has never looked better.

Tumbler Ridge is seeking healthcare professionals to our growing and vibrant community. To complement existing services, we are currently targeting nurses of all specialties, counsellors and paramedics. There are also opportunities for independent alternative health care professions such as chiropractors, physiotherapists and naturopaths.
